Writing	<p>Listen to the story: If Kids Ruled the World</p> <p>https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=ybQ3vRt4XaA</p> <p>Get a piece of paper from home. Use a "think sheet" to write down some ideas of what you would like to see if YOU ruled the world.</p> <p>Now get another paper to write your story. Remember to use nice, neat printing, capital letters, spacing, periods, and try to sound out the words as best as you can.</p> <p>Keep your story and bring it back to school so we can share our stories with the class. You can also have your mom take a picture of your story and send it to me on Remind.</p>
Reading	<p>Raz Kids – Read books at your level and answer the questions.</p> <p>I have also assigned a story for Mother's Day. It may be too hard for you to read by yourself, but you can listen to it as well.</p>
Math	<p>Quick Addition and Subtraction Recall with 2 Dice</p> <p>Start with adding first. Roll 2 dice and add them together as quickly as you can. Write down the equation on a piece of paper. When you have finished some addition facts, switch to subtraction. Roll 2 dice, decide which is the greater number and then subtract the smaller number.
